Dear President,

I wish to express my grave concern over the extra judicial murder of NELSON WLADIMIRO CURINIR LINCOQUEO in 1973. On the night of 5<sup>th</sup> October 1973 a heavily armed group of men in air force uniforms forcibly entered the home of Mr Lincoqueo. The armed men said that they were taking Mr Lincoqueo to the Maquehar air force base. On 18<sup>th</sup> October his relatives heard a radio announcement that Mr. Lincoqueo had escaped and there were orders for his capture, dead or alive. However, this announcement appears to have been a lie as witnesses have testified that Mr Lincoqueo was taken out of the Maquehar base by

members of the air force on 13<sup>th</sup> October 1973. That was the last time Mr Lincoqueo was seen alive.

The air force officers presumably murdered him. His body was found on the banks of the River Cautin and was buried in a cemetery near Temuco. The body was exhumed in 1990 on the mandate of the CNVR. The autopsy found he had been shot in the back of the head.

I urge you to investigate this murder so that the full truth may emerge and that those responsible are brought to justice. This action is urgently needed to prevent other appalling human rights abuses in the future. Respected, international human rights groups such as Amnesty International state that Chile's amnesty law of 1978 is an obstacle to clarifying past incidents and preventing their re-occurrence. Thus I also strongly urge you to repeal this law.

Thank you for your time. I await news of you



actions on these two matters.
