I would like to express my grave concern about the extra judicial execution of Nelson Wladimiro Curinir Lincoguelo

On September 11, 1973 the government of

President Salvador Allende was overthrown. On Oct. 5 several heavily armed men entered the home of Nelson Curinir a 22 year old activist in the Communist party. The armed men said they were taking Nelson Curinir to the Maquehua air force base. He was never seen by his family again. The family heard a radio announcement on Oct. 18 that said Nelson Curinir had escaped while being transferred by military patrol to Temuco prison. Witnesses confirmed that Nelson Curinir had been taken out of the air force base in Maquehua. In March 1990 a Mapuche Indian came forward and said Nelson Curinir's body had been found on the banks of the River Cautin in 1973 and that he had been buried as "name unknown" in a cemetery near Temuco. Autopsy reports showed Nelson Curinir was shot in the back of the head.

I am very concerned about unresolved human rights violations against indigenous peoples, including Nelson Wladimiro Curinir Lincoguelo. I implore you to do any thing in your power to rectify the situation.

Dear Mr. President,

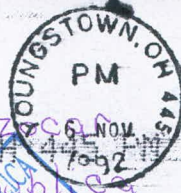

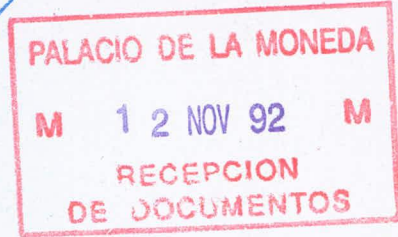
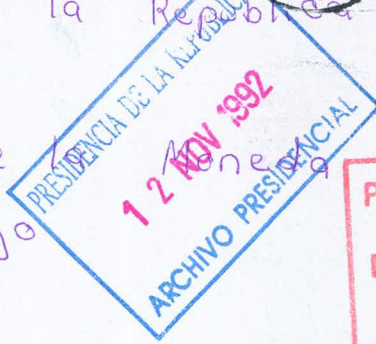
