Dear President,

I believe in free speech and I am always greatly concerned about the violation of anyone's human rights

This year, 1992, is in many countries being marked as the 500th anniversary of the arrival of Europeans on the continent. I, therefore feel that this seems a particularly appropriate time to highlight concerns with respect to for unresolved human rights violations against indigenous peoples of, what is now known as the Americas. The one case that this letter is particularly concerned with is that of Nelson Wladimir Curwin-Liscoqueo.

I am gravely concerned about the extrajudicial execution of this person in 1973.

I would welcome the investigations into Nelson Curwin's killing and hope that the full truth that will eventually emerge. It is also my hope that those responsible for his death will be brought to justice. I believe, along with all members and associates of Amnesty International, that those responsible for such an act of human rights violation as this and all others in Chile must be brought to justice. Only then will such atrocities be prevented from recurring.

We believe that the amnesty of 1978 constitutes an obstacle to clarifying past abuses and preventing their recurrence. Therefore we
