Your Excellency:

We are delighted to be sending you the Inter-American Dialogue's just released consensus policy report--Convergence and Community: The Americas in 1993. It calls for the construction of a Western Hemisphere Community of Democracies--a grouping of economically integrated nations of the Americas with membership contingent upon a commitment to democratic governance and respect for human rights.

The report sets forth a strategy for:

. expanding the North American Free Trade Area to enhance the region's global competitiveness. The governments of the Americas should establish a new multilateral organization to guide and coordinate progress toward economic integration;

. protecting and advancing the democratic gains of the past decade in Latin America and the Caribbean, and for acting collectively where democracy is threatened or violated. The Organization of American States should be prepared to send civilian missions to countries where internal order is severely threatened; and

. combatting mass poverty and profound income disparities in the hemisphere. The proposed integration strategy is firmly grounded in social justice and democratic practice.

Ninety-four prominent individuals from throughout the hemisphere have endorsed the report, including, from the United States, Bruce Babbitt, Henry Cisneros, A.W. Clausen, Dianne Feinstein, Modesto Maidique, Jessica T. Mathews, Federico Peña, Charles Pilliod, Jr., Elliot Richardson, and Peter Tarnoff; and from Latin America, Raúl Alfonsín, Enrique Iglesias, Augustín Legorreta, Javier Pérez de Cuéllar, Sonia Picado, Luís Inácio "Lula" da Silva, Gabriel Valdés, and Mario Vargas Llosa.

I hope you enjoy reading the report. We would be most interested in receiving your reaction.

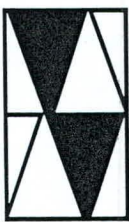


