As a member of Amnesty International I want to express my serious concern at the "disappearance" of José Julio Llaulén Antilao and Juan Eleuterio Cheuquepán Levimilla on 11 June 1974 following their detention by members of carabineros police.

As a member of Amnesty International I welcome the investigations into "disappearances" and hope very much that those responsible will be brought to justice.

I also hope that investigations into the "disappearance" of five other Mapuches, Miguel Eduardo Yaufulén Mañil, José Domingo Yaufulén Mañil, Oscar Romualdo Yaufulén Mañil, Antonio Ceferino Yaufulén Mañil and Samuel Huichallán Llanquilén, arrested on 11 June 1974 will lead to clarification of their fate and that those responsible will be brought to justice.

My view is that full investigations are essential not only to inform the relatives about the fate of their loved ones but also to make sure that "disappearances" or similar violations of human rights never happen again.
