Dear Mr. President:

We appreciate the efforts made by many countries to help find a solution to the conflict in Cambodia. As more than a thousand Cambodian survivors, who found asylum and refuge abroad, we write to you now because, in spite of some of the progress made at the series of meetings of the five Permanent Members of the UN Security Council, we are very worried about the deteriorating situation on the ground in Cambodia -- senseless, more widespread fighting; increasing casualties, cold-blooded massacres, internal refugees, dislocation, instability, repression and political crackdowns.

Despite numerous efforts and development fundamentally Cambodia seems still trapped between the crocodile and the tiger: caught in the vice-like jaws of the larger neighbor; or being torn apart again by the fierce communist killers known to the world as the Khmer Rouge.

Because your government is involved in the considerations of the situation in Cambodia by the international community, we urge you to support ten urgent steps toward peace and human rights in Cambodia:

1. Complete Vietnamese military withdrawal under UN verification;
2. Genuine and full self-determination;
3. The Australian proposal for an enhanced UN role;
4. A complaint to the International Court against the Khmer Rouge genocide;
5. UN provision prohibiting the discredited Khmer Rouge leaders from coming back to positions of political or military power;
6. A more comprehensive and balanced approach to the Cambodia problem by the UN General Assembly;
7. A direct link between the complete, verified Vietnamese withdrawal and the non-return of the genocidal regime;
8. Strong enabling provisions for human rights promotion and protection in Cambodia;
9. A cease-fire and end of arms supplies to all factions;
10. Neutral sites and better UN protection for refugees.

## OUR CONCERNS

We are concerned that while Vietnam apparently withdrew military units last September, this did not take place under international verification. And now there are numerous reports that Vietnamese military units and personnel have returned.

We are concerned that even after Vietnam substantially withdrew military units, the international community was, and still is, slow to take measures to delegitimize, isolate and marginalize the leaders of the Khmer Rouge killers. We are concerned that, despite appeals from Cambodian survivors, no action is being taken to hold accountable under international law the individuals and state responsible for the Cambodian genocide, and that there is no provision to preclude from returning to positions of political power those most responsible for the Cambodian genocide: the 1975-1979 members of the Standing and Central Committees, and the ranking members of the security apparatus of the Communist Party of Kampuchea.

We are concerned that there are even now attempts to deny and ignore the Khmer Rouge genocide and reduce these terrible crimes to a non-issue in the resolution of the Cambodian conflict. And we are concerned that the United Nation's resolutions on Cambodia can be interpreted as opening the door to a return to power by the Khmer Rouge.

We are worried that tigers and crocodiles can be clever and tenacious. As Cambodians, we now both the Vietnamese and the Khmer Route very well. The Vietnamese disguise -- through slogans of "special relationship" and "militant solidarity" -- their intention to maintain a degree of influence incompatible with true independence, neutrality and non-alignment for Cambodia.

For their part, the Khmer Rouge plan to hide their real leaders in the jungle, surrounded by the hardcore fighters and killers, who will only superficially disarm. Other leaders are sent out to participate in the negotiating and political process still under the orders and discipline of the discredited leadership. The above-ground, nominal leaders will try to stall the negotiating process and elections until the armed cadres have enough time to continue to spread out throughout the countryside creating "half-liberated zones" where, regardless of who controls by day, the Khmer Rouge control by night. This way the Khmer Rouge cadre will attempt to "direct the ballot" in elections that will be more complex and problematic than those which the UN has supervised so far.

Thus, we believe that a comprehensive solution to the Cambodia conflict must guard against the clever stealth of the tiger and the tenaciousness of the crocodile. When the Cambodia negotiations began in Jakarta, under the leadership of Indonesia, the Jakarta Informal Meetings recognized the direct relationship between the Vietnamese withdrawal and the non-return of the genocidal regime. These dual concerns remain valid today. And we hope this will be remembered as the negotiations progress.

To the full extent you are able, we would ask your government make sure that the effort to achieve an internationally negotiated solution to the Cambodia conflict deals comprehensively with both aspects of the Cambodia problem.

## **OUR APPEAL: TEN STEPS TOWARD PEACE AND HUMAN RIGHTS FOR CAMBODIA.**

1. We ask your government to insist that Vietnam completely withdraw from Cambodia under UN verification and that international assessment and verification not be deliberately stalled or postponed.
2. Until such time as a genuine act of self-determination has taken place and Cambodians are able to freely choose their government, we ask your government to continue to insist on the need for true Cambodian self-determination.
3. We appeal to your government to support the proposal put forward by Australia for an enhanced UN role in the resolution of the Cambodia conflict.
4. To achieve national reconciliation, it is necessary to construct situations that will enable the rank and file of the Khmer Rouge to peacefully re-integrate into Cambodian economic, social and political life. However, as long as the real leaders -- who are still the 1975-79 members Standing and Central Committees of the Communist Party of Kampuchea -- remain at the head of the Khmer Rouge and within the territory or jurisdiction of Cambodia, we ask your government to urge or join with other Signatories to bring a case to the International Court of Justice under the provisions of the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide.
5. Because we do not see how allowing those responsible for genocide to hold positions of political leadership can be considered compatible with well established international law requiring accountability and punishment for those responsible for systematic torture and mass murder, we appeal to your government to work to insure that the resolutions on the situation in Cambodia set forth by the international community for the comprehensive, just and lasting resolution of the Cambodia conflict include a provision on the non-return to positions of political power or authority by those responsible for "what the UN General Assembly calls the "universally condemned policies and practices of the recent past."
6. And while the next United Nations debate on Cambodia is several months off, we ask your government to urge and support a more comprehensive approach to a political settlement of the Cambodia problem by the Credentials Committee and General Assembly, and a clear resolution that cannot be interpreted as opening the door to the return to power by the Khmer Rouge.
7. Bearing in mind that Cambodia is still caught between the tiger and crocodile, we ask that your government seek to insure that the Cambodian negotiations maintain the direct relationship established at the Jakarta negotiations between an internationally verified complete Vietnamese withdrawal and the non-return to genocidal policies and practices.

Of course, we know that Vietnam mentions the Cambodian genocide problem to further its own political self-interest. But that does not make the reality or consequences of the Cambodian genocide any less real. The denial of the Cambodian killing fields is not a step toward peace. Ignoring the Cambodian genocide is not a step to preventing its re-occurrence.


In the absence of a genocide case at the World Court, or recognition and remedy through the competent organs of the UN, we especially appeal to countries that believe in human rights and democracy and those countries that want independence and neutrality for Cambodia to ensure that the reality and consequences of the Cambodian genocide will not be denied or ignored at the negotiating forums where the future of Cambodia will be determined.

8. In light of the severe human rights problems which have afflicted Cambodia for over twenty years now, we ask that your country work to ensure that a comprehensive solution have thoroughly considered and fully developed enabling provisions for effective measures on human rights training, education, monitoring, reporting, and review so that fundamental freedoms for the Cambodian people can be promoted and protected.

9. Again, we appreciate very much the efforts that several countries are making to resolve the Cambodia crisis. Nonetheless, warfare intensifies, and Khmer kill Khmer with guns, bullets, rockets and landmines not made in Cambodia. Thus, we ask your government to support the recent appeals by the Prime Minister of Thailand for a ceasefire and an end to arms shipments to all the Cambodian factions.

10. And lastly, concerned about continuing reports of ongoing brutality against displaced Cambodians in Thailand and mindful of the need for increased protection for Cambodian refugees, may be also appeal to your government to support the proposal of the Thai government that neutral sites under UN administration be established for displaced Cambodians in Thailand who would choose refuse there, so that Cambodians displaced and still victimized by the fighting can, with protection against additional abductions and forced repatriation, find freedom of choice as the first step to voluntary and safe repatriation to Cambodia.

Thank you for your consideration. We appreciate the opportunity to discuss our concerns with representatives of your government.
