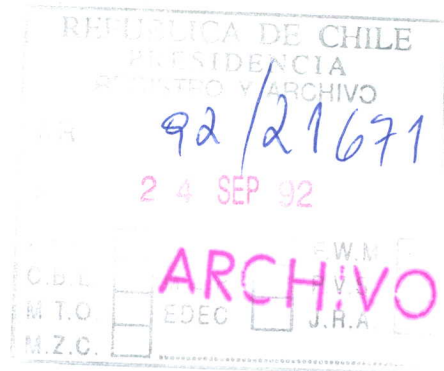



I am writing to you on behalf of three Peruvian men, Mauro González Quispe, René Larico Alguilar, and Lisbert Fausto Manini Morales. Sentenced to death for the murder of two Chilean students in January 1992.

President Aylwin, although publicly opposed to the death penalty, has not as yet granted clemency in death penalty cases which come before him. I strongly urge him and all members of his cabinet to do as they said they would and uphold the struggle against the death penalty and also oppression and torture. In the name of human rights, I ask you to grant clemency to Mauro, René, and Lisbert. As a freely elected government, I hope that democracy and democratic ideals are upheld.
