Dear Mr. President:

Greetings again from the Tom and Becky Kornas. As you will recall from our February 2, 1993 letter we promised to send you information on our unique Orange Monkey program.

Orange Monkey is a concept that will provide assistance to organizations that need to raise funds for it's projects that are usually not covered by the funds it may already receive. We have set up a company called Orange Monkey Concessions that will work with companies in the food, drink and concession supplies industries such as Gold Medal Products. I had a meeting in the world headquarters in Cincinnati, Ohio with Mr. Dan Kroeger president of Gold Medal Products. Through it's distributors Mr. Kroeger has informed me they will be able to offer discounted prices and or free use of their concession equipment to deserving organization Orange Monkey has been in contact with.

We plan to work with these companies to teach deserving non-profit organizations how to raise their own funds. It is sort of like teaching a man to fish instead of just giving him a fish. My wife and I have already donated a popcorn machine and a cotton candy machine to a local mental health/rehabilitation center (Weaver School and Workshop, located in Akron, Ohio U.S.A.) for children. It is very important to me that you understand why I choose to do this and exactly what I want to do with my life. I am 40 years old and never thought I would have a child. Last year on March 26, 1992 my wife and I were blessed with a very healthy girl named Hillary Juanita Kornas. We felt overwhelmed we were given this opportunity of celebrating the birth of a healthy child. There are so many children in the world today born

into poor health, poverty and improper education world it becomes somewhat unimaginable to think global impact on a child's life. I decided to do something with my life that will hopefully assist the world as possible. My wife and I talk about goals for the well being of all children. I believe I have a special intuition to make a difference in this

We are very serious about our programs. I have to say however being an average man in today's world of technology it is difficult to get anyone to listen to you and we are being serious.

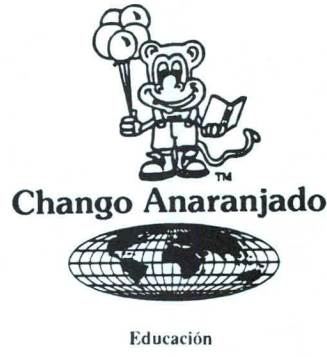

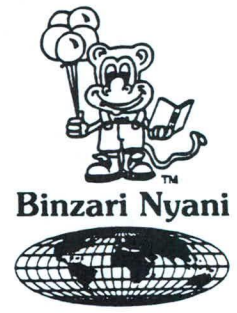

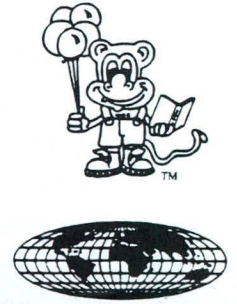
