

I am writing today to request a few minutes of your valuable time to consider the case of Carlos Patricio Duran Gonzalez. Sr. Duran was one of 13 government opponents who disappeared during November and December of 1976. He was never heard from again after taking his children to Mapocho station in Santiago on December 18, 1976.

On January 31, 1977 the Supreme Court authorized a special investigation into 8 of the 13 cases by the Court of Appeals. The investigation eventually included 10 of the 13 cases and concluded in Judge Carlos Cerdá's indictments of 40 people on August 14, 1986. As you know, Judge Cerdá's investigation established the existence of a secret squad composed of various Chilean military and police officers which was responsible for at least some of the disappearances. The issuance of false documents by police to cover up the death of some prisoners was also established.

As you may not know, Sr. Duran's case is one of the three cases never included in the special investigation for technical reasons. Since substantial amounts of new evidence have surfaced since 1977, an investigation of Sr. Duran's case would now be much more likely to resolve his disappearance.

I respectfully request that you use the powers of your distinguished office to urge a re-examination of the case of Sr. Duran and an investigation into his disappearance as soon as possible. Sr. Duran's family has been waiting over 11 years now for his case to be resolved and deserves at least an inquiry into his case.





On January 31, 1977, the Supreme Court authorized a special investigation into 8 of the 13 cases. Judge Carlos Cerdas investigation established the use of secret squads of Chilean ~~and~~ military and police officers, responsible for at least some of the disappearances. My big question is why are the squads secret? And how is their dental health. As may not know, I believe in proper dental care as well as basic human rights. I urge you use your powers of your distinguished office to ensure proper dental health for all Chilean people. I also urge you to bring to a quick conclusion the disappearance of Sr. Duran and relieve his family of 13 years of agony, and possible bad dental health. I feel that an inquiry into his case deserves some attention.
