Your Excellency,

I am a twenty four year old British
 with a keen interest in human rights. I recently
 wrote to you asking you to commute the death sentence
 on Mauro González Quispe, René Larico Aguilar and
 Fausto Munari Morales. It is with gratitude I thank
 you for commuting their sentence was a noble and
 just act.

Unfortunately I am writing to ask again that you be
 successful yet again. Several other death sentences have
 been brought to my attention. These include Rafael
 Henríquez, sentenced to death for kidnapping Cristian
 Edwards, and Juan Domingo Salvo Zuriga sentenced for
 killing a policeman.

I would like to state that my opposition to the death
 is motivated by a belief that it transgresses
 and fundamental human rights and is in no way
 morally justifiable. I believe morally and logically, the two
 need to be exclusive, that capital punishment is
 not just. It does not act as a deterrent and it dispenses
 with all notion of reform. If we do not have hope that
 human beings can change for the better there are very
 few grounds for hope.

Once again I would like to thank you for commuting the
 sentences mentioned at the beginning of this letter. I
 hope the powers of your office may help you save the
 lives of the others mentioned.
