However, I think we both share a serious concern regarding the death sentence of Rafael Escorza Henriquez. I respectfully requets Your Excellency to excercise the power of clemency to commute his death sentence.

As an individual and member of Amnesty International I totally oppose death penalty.

I know Your Excellency share a severe scepticism against the pratice of death penalty. A total abolition of this kind of penalty in Chile would ensure long-term respect for human rights as proclaimed in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.
