Having learned that on 19 October 1992 the Supreme Court confirmed the death sentence against **Juan Domingo Salvo Zůñiga**, I do not hesitate to address you.

I respectfully request that you, Mr President, will exercise your power of clemency and commute the death sentence against Juan Salvo Zůñiga.

I want to stress that Amnesty International opposes the death sentence in all cases without reservation, on the grounds that it is the ultimate cruel, inhuman and degrading punishment.

Knowing that you have already commuted death sentences while you have been a president, I hope you will work for the total abolition of the death penalty in Chile in line with the worldwide trend.
