

Your Excellency:



I am writing to you out of grave concern about reports conveyed by Amnesty International-U.S.A. that the Comité de Defensa de los Derecho del Pueblo (CODEPU) received nine death threats by phone on 29 January 1992 after having their office broken into in the early hours of the same day. The callers, identifying themselves as the Frente Nacionalista de Combate, claimed they knew who the members of CODEPU were, and asserted they would kill them.

I wish to urge that the source of these threats be investigated immediately and that those responsible for the break-in and the death threats be brought to justice. I entreat you, further, to take adequate steps to protect the lives and insure the physical well-being of all members of CODEPU.

I would like you to know, your Excellency, that my concern for the basic rights of CODEPU (and of all human beings) is not of a political nature. Thanking you in advance for your attention to this important and urgent matter,
