Excelencia Sr. Presidente de la República,

I am writing to express my concern about the disappearance of ANTONIO ANINAO MORALES, a farmer who lived near Melipenco. On 11 September 1973, a patrol of carabinieri, without showing an arrest warrant, took him to the police station at Llaina, where he remained for 8 days. He was released but ordered to report to the police station three times a day. On 24 September, when he reported there, he was detained.

I am pleased at the news that the case is being investigated by the Segundo Juzgado del Crimen, and hope that these investigations will reveal the truth about the abduction of Antonio Aninao Morales and result in those responsible for it being brought to justice. This latter has a significance which goes beyond this individual case, as it may help prevent future abuses: the 1990 report of the United Nations Working Group on Enforced or Involuntary Disappearances says that 'perhaps the single most important

factor contributing to the phenomenon of disappearances may be that of impurity'.

I appreciate that you have many important duties, but I would be very grateful if you could inform me of any progress in the case of Antonio Anivar Morales.
