- requesting Your Excellency to exercise Your power of clemency and commute the death sentence against Juan Salvo Zúñiga;
- stating that Amnesty International opposes the death penalty in all cases without reservation, on the grounds that it is the ultimate, inhuman and degrading punishment;
- calling for the total abolition of the death penalty in Chile in line with the worldwide trend.
