Your Excellency,

I am very happy to learn of the Presidents decision to commute the death sentences on Mauro Gonzalez Quispe, Rene Larico Aguilar and Lisbert Fausto Mamani Morales.

I am, however, concerned about Rafael Escorza Henriquez who has been sentenced to death. I cannot help requesting President Aylwin to exercise his power of clemency again on behalf of Mr. Escorza.

I, as a member of Amnesty International, am opposed to the death penalty and am obliged to call for the total abolition of the death penalty in Chile. I am sure its abolition would ensure long-term respect for the human rights of all peoples, regardless of nationality, which the death penalty clearly violates.
