Your Excellency,

I am a student in Sweden and I am writing to You to express my serious concern about the possible transferral to military jurisdiction of investigations into the "disappearance" of Alfonso Chanfreau Oyarce in 1974, in the context of the repeated failure of the military courts to investigate cases of human rights violations and to bring those responsible to justice.

Also, on behalf of Amnesty International, I am writing to express the concern about the impunity of those responsible for human rights violations during the former military government.

Therefore I am urging the government to ensure that those responsible are brought to justice so that the full truth in cases like that of Alfonso Chanfreau Oyarce can be revealed. I am also asking the government to repeal the 1978 Amnesty Law (Decree Law 2191) which has prevented and continues to obstruct full judicial investigations into abuses committed before 1978.
