Dear Sir,

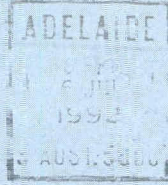
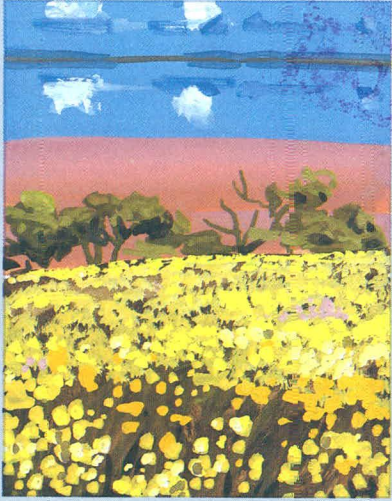

The people who commit these wicked things, surely can't be happy? Everything in Australia isn't perfect either, but at least we don't torture our fellow men and women, and children.

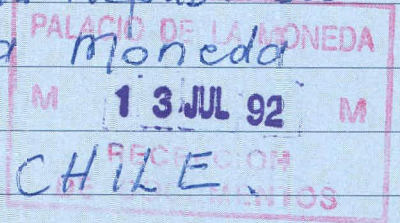
