

As a member of Amnesty International, a world-wide organization concerned with freedom of opinion and the defence of nonviolent political prisoners in every part of the world and under every kind of regime I warmly welcome the decision of Your Excellency to commute the death sentences of **Mauro González Quispe, René Larico Aguilar** and **Lisbeth Mamani Morales**.

Despite that I am seriously concern that **Rafael Escorza Henríquez** has been sentenced to death. I respectfully request Your Excellency to exercise your power to clemency to commute his death sentence.

Amnesty International opposes the death penalty in all cases as a violation to the right to life and the right not to be subjected to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment, as proclaimed in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.


