

ROYAL PORTRAIT ARTIST

THE REGAL STORY OF RALPH WOLFE COWAN

With over 2,000 portraits to his credit, Ralph Wolfe Cowan of Palm Beach, Florida is doubtless one of the nation's most prolific artists. Examine his list of commissions and a startling fact emerges: for the last quarter of a century, Ralph Wolfe Cowan has been the royal portrait artist to more reigning monarchs than any other living painter. At the young age of 53, Cowan has already painted HRM King Hassan II, HRM King Fahd, HSH Prince Rainier II, HSH Princess Grace, HRM Crown Prince Abdullah, HSH Prince Albert, HSH Princess Caroline, HSH Princess Stephanie and HM Hassanal Bolkiah of Brunei. Add to these three portraits of His Holiness Pope John Paul II, Presidents Kennedy, Johnson, Carter and Reagan of the United States, President Marcos of the Phillippines and President Gorbachev of the Soviet Union, and you have one of the most impressive lists of commissions in the country.

Cowan's fascinating life and his adventures in portraiture would make an interesting

book - I be had the time to write it. Fortunately, Louise Atkinson interviewed him and prepared this revealing article in which she talls how he came to enter the world of oyally and of his experiences with its kings and queens.

At age four, beginning with a protrait of his mother, Ralph Cowan knew he was destined to paint people. Before leaving Portsmouth. Virginia at the age of 16 to study at the Art Students League in New York, he had painted most of the hometown notables and copied many of the old masters - Rembrandt, Van Dyke, Rubens and Reynolds. In Manhattan, he continued these studies, copying originals at the Metropolitan Museum of Art.

As a member of the 11th Airborne Division in the early 1950's, he painted 22 generals and other military dignitaries. Soon, he also began painting stage and screen celebrities Johnny Mathis used his protrait on his first album. Later came portraits of socialities from Palm Beach, New York and

California. His clients and friends were the "who's who" of the world. He even painted Kentucky Derby winner Majestic Prince.

Cowan believes the young protrait artist must use every possible bit of ingenuity to get commissions. In 1956, he followed his own advice in arranging to paint Princess Grace. "I read that Prince Rainier and Princess Grace were in town and I wanted very much to paint the beautiful princess. First, I called dress designer Louis Estevez and borrowed his most elegant long gown. Then I called Twentieth Century Fox to see her unreleasec movie, The Swan. Afterward, I borrowed some 'stills.' I hired a model that resembled Princess Grace and began the pcrt-ait. When the painting was finished, I had an 8 x 10 color photograph delivered to the prince's public relations man, Rupert Allen. At four o'clock that day, he arrived with Prince Rainier. The prince, a very handsome man, looked at the portrait and said, in perfect English, that he was very jealous of me. With a
